Pro Tips From the Frontlines

Time your purchase with Sweden's Midsummer sales (June-July)

Ask about refurbished models - saves 25-40% with same 5-year warranty

Beware of "Swedish-designed" imitations made elsewhere

Still wondering if these prices justify the plunge? Consider this: A recent study by KTH Royal Institute showed Swedish-made welders have 37% lower lifecycle costs than competitors. That's like getting the ABBA gold album collection thrown in for free.
