How much electricity does Ecuador use per capita? Per capita energy consumption is around 0.83 toe, a level 35% below the South American average (). Per capita electricity consumption is approximately 1 500 kWh. In its Electricity Master Plan -, Ecuador estimated that its power capacity should increase by 4 GW by to face a 7%/year increase in electricity demand. What type of energy does Ecuador use? Ecuador's renewable energy is comprised of hydro power (5,419 MW), biomass (MW), wind (71 MW), photovoltaic (29 MW), and biogas (11 MW). Hydroelectric power plants are in three regions: coastal (2 provinces), Andes (9 provinces), and Amazon (4 provinces). How much energy did Ecuador lose in ?
