How have residential electricity costs been revised? residential costs back to the year ended March have been revised based on consistent information provided by all electricity retailers. Some retailers have also provided revised data back to the year ended March . This has been incorporated into the residential electricity cost data. How do you calculate residential electricity cost per unit? The residential electricity cost per unit is derived by dividing the dollar value of residential electricity sales by the number of kilowatt-hours (kWh) sold to residential customers. The survey also reports the 'lines' component of the residential costs. This covers both the distribution and transmission components of the residential costs. How much does an electricity retailer charge a consumer? An electricity retailer may charge a consumer 100 cents/day and 22c/kWh of electricity consumed. 26.6 c/kWh -- that is,  $(/)\times 100$ . If the Retailer offered a 10% prompt payment discount, the final cost to the consumer would be 23.9 c/kWh. The line charge component is calculated in a similar manner (all figures include GST). The QSDEP is a price indicator series that complements sales-based electricity cost data. Does the qsdep reflect what customers actually paid for electricity? This provides a handy indicator of how price changes may impact on consumers. However, it does not reflect what customers have actually paid for electricity in any particular period, as the QSDEP only models one type of customer in each city or town, when in reality, consumption and pricing plans vary significantly across households. How many kWh does a retailer consume a day? o They consume an average of around 22 kWh per day. This equates to an annual consumption of kWh. o They are on the current advertised prices for the plans surveyed by the Ministry for each retailer in each region. This represents the headline, publicly advertised retail plan for new customers for each retailer without a fixed term contract. New Zealand Average Electricity Cost: Residential data is updated quarterly, averaging 0.294 NZD/kWh from Jun . At the end of September , Kiwis homes consumed, on average, about 7000kWh per year. This works out to cost roughly \$197 per month, if the current average kilowatt (kWh) price is 33.74 cents.
